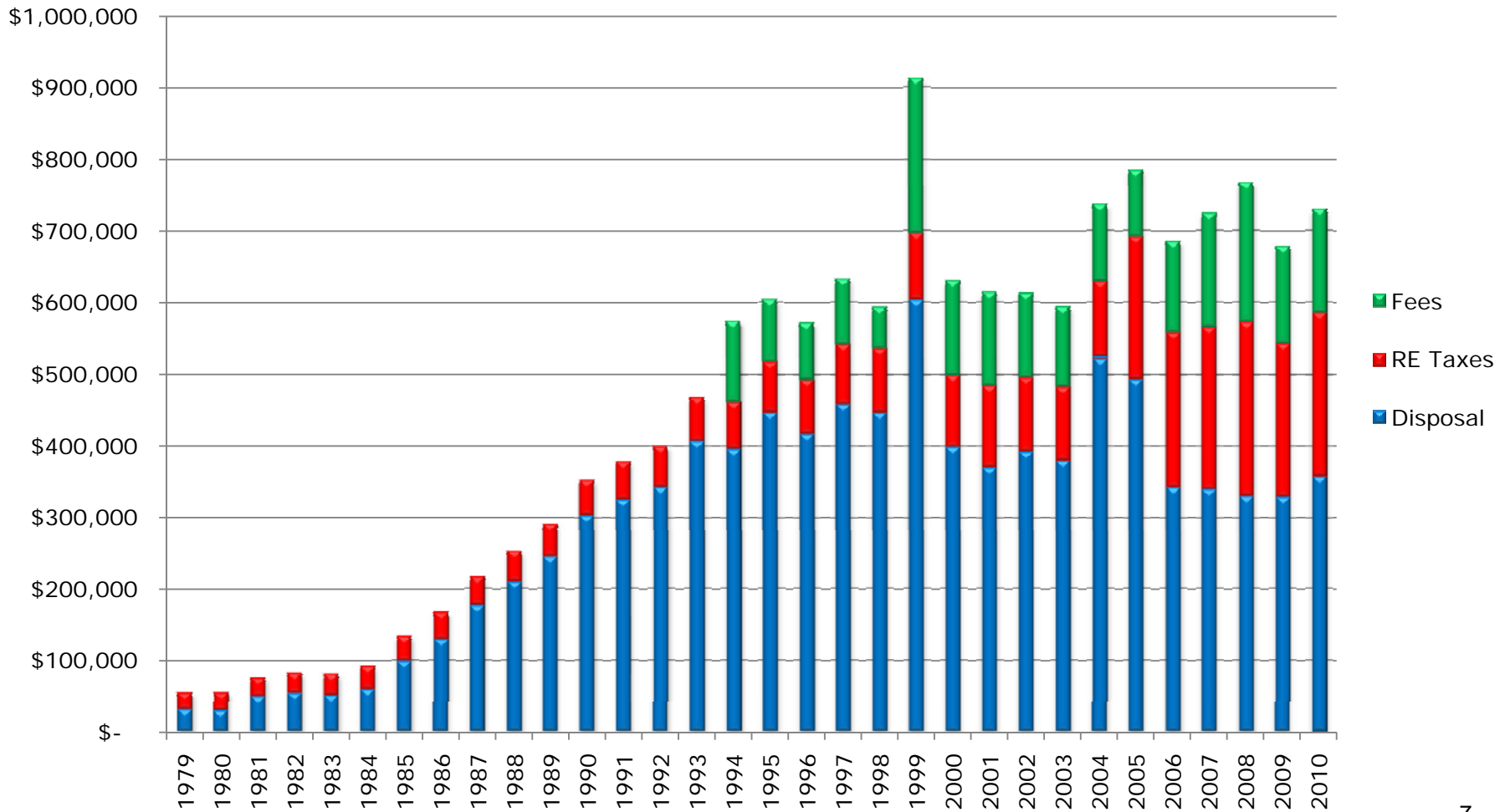

2013 - 2037:

Increased Disposal Cost: \$ 49,766,896

Decreased RE Taxes: \$ 2,254,099

Lost Landfill Fees: \$ 12,500,000

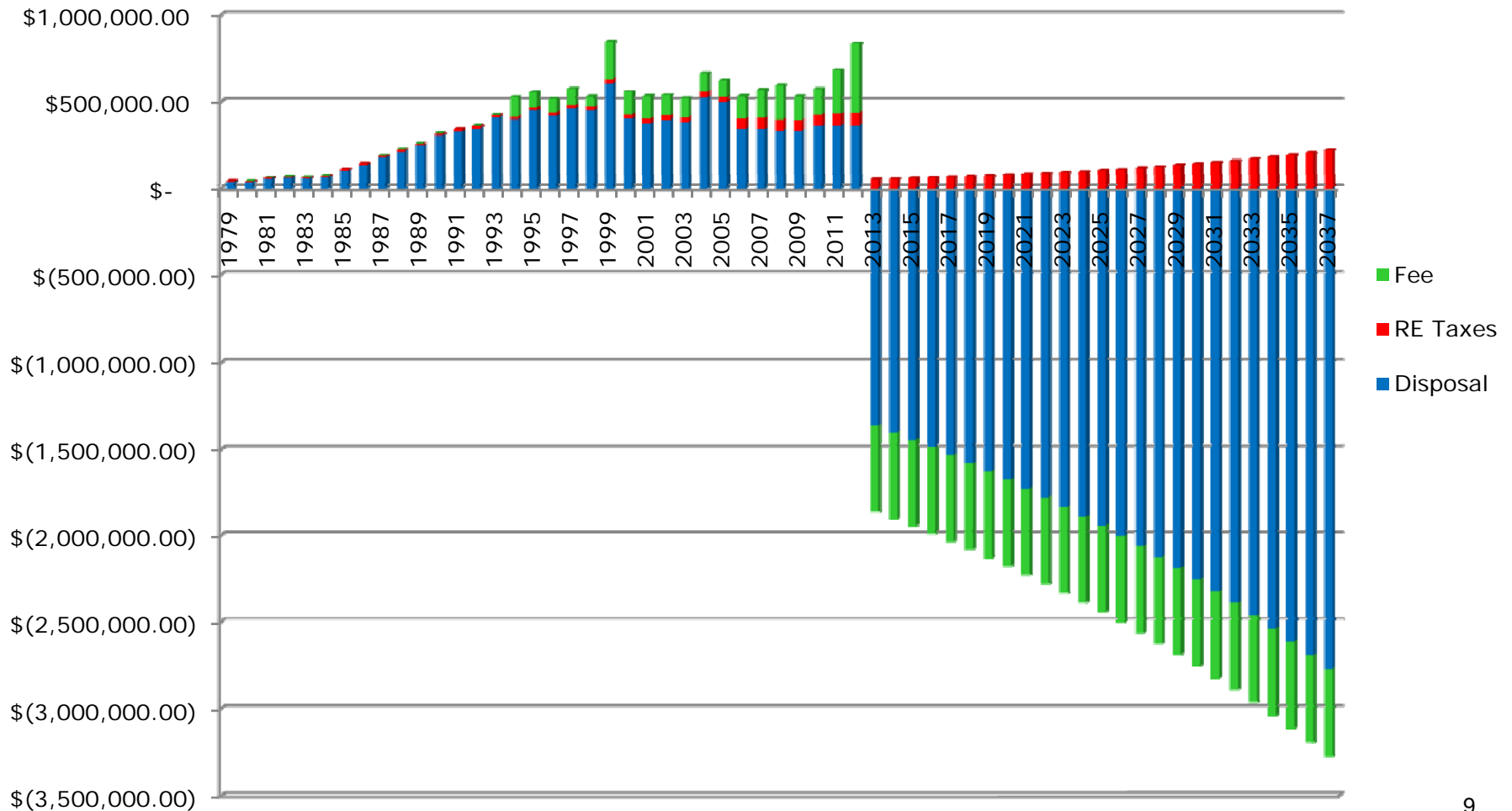
TOTAL LOSS: \$ 64,520,995

Estimated Economic Benefits of Landfill Expansion

2013 – 2037:

Disposal Savings: \$ 19,289,121

Real Estate Taxes: \$ 23,182,821

Landfill Fees: \$ 12,500,000

TOTAL: \$ 54,971,942
